

Habitat Pinwheel House

(16 houses): * You could also do 12 houses (3 rows of 4)

For each house cut: 1. 7 1/2" x 4" for roof Make flying geese.
2. 4" x 4" background sky

Cut 4 1. 4" x 4" squares for house
Cut 4 2. 4" x 4 " squares for pinwheel - fold wrong sides
together into triangle, press, fold again, press. place raw edge
along 4"house square. Sew scant seam. Make 4 per
house. Assemble into a pinwheel. Sew 4 squares together. Attach
roof. Sew 4 houses together per row.

Adding side pieces: cut 4 (*3) - 11" x 2 1/2" strips. With right
sides together, stitch a side piece to the left side of the first house, on
the second row, sew the side piece to the right side of last house.
Third row side piece on the left and last row side piece on the right.

Sashing between rows of houses: Cut 3 (*2) pieces 34" x 2
1/2" You may use a green for grass, brown for path, or use the
same color you used for sky.

Border: Cut 2 1/2 " border (you can match the background or
use another coordinating color).

Backing: 38" x 56" (less if doing 3 rows of 4 houses)
