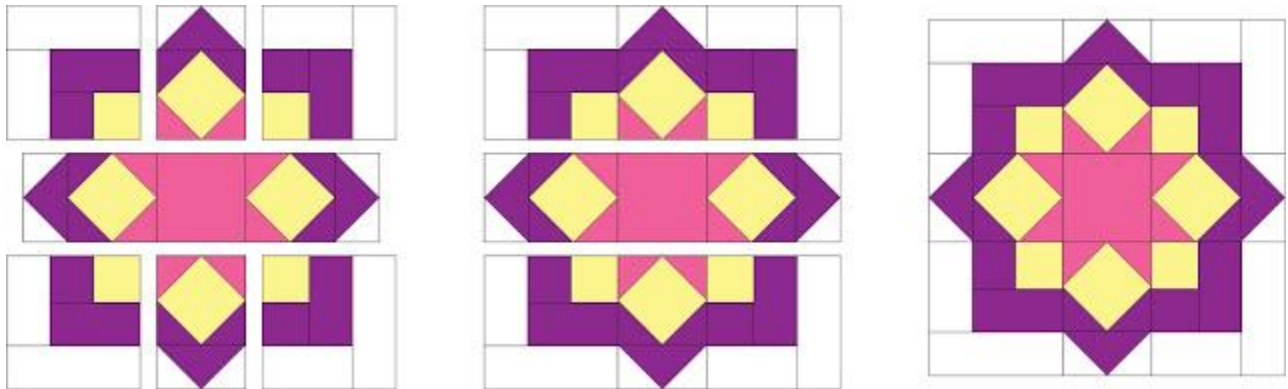


## NOVEMBER -- 7th CLUE and REVEAL!!

And now, the final instructions! Assembling the blocks and making the quilt top.  
One of the nice things about using these really big blocks is that there are only 10 to piece together so sewing them into your quilt top should be pretty quick.

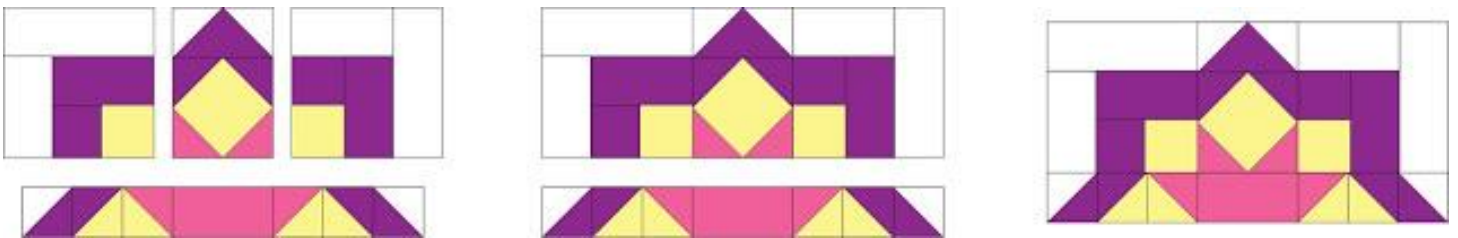
1. **Full Blocks** - Combine **2** Unit-1, **1** Unit-2, and **4** Quarter Courthouse Step Units as illustrated below, pressing all seams open. The full block should measure  $24\frac{1}{2}'' \times 24\frac{1}{2}''$ .

Repeat for a total of **8 full blocks**.



2. **Half Blocks** - Combine **1** Unit-1, **1** Unit-3, and **2** Quarter Courthouse Step Units as illustrated below, pressing all seams open. The half block should measure  $24\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ .

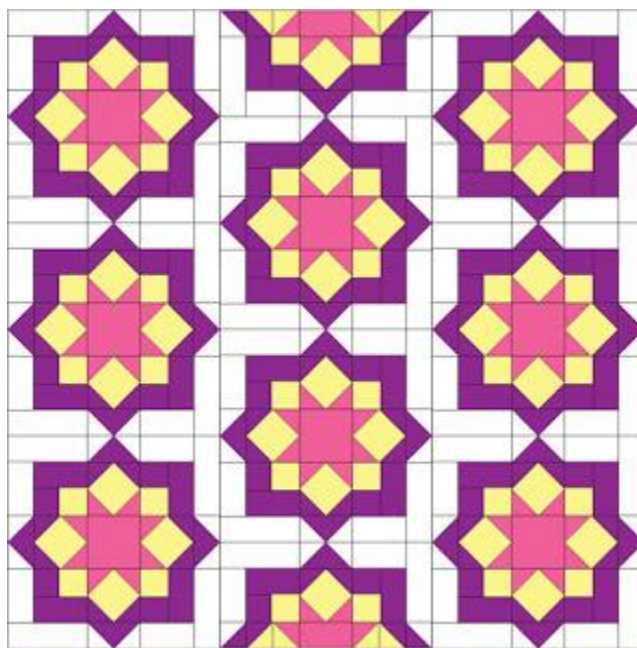
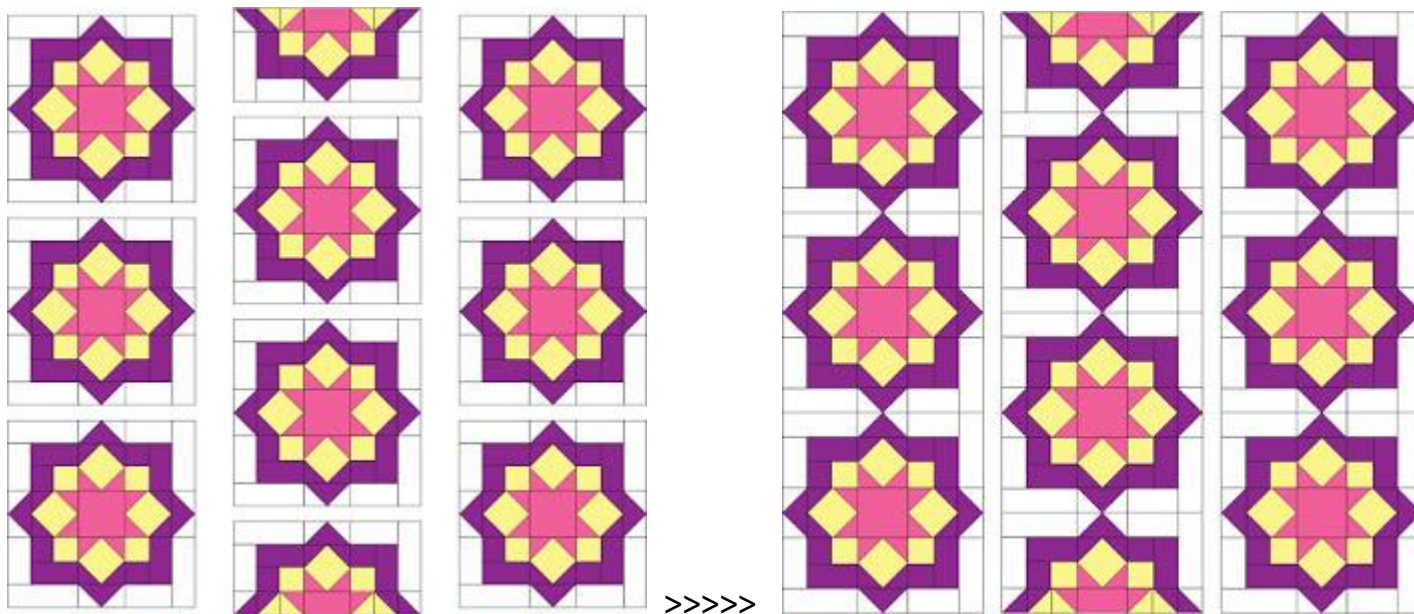
Repeat for a total of **2 half blocks**.



## Quilt Top Assembly

Assemble the quilt top using 8 full blocks (24 ½" x 24 ½") and 2 half blocks (24 ½" x 12 ½").

Arrange blocks according to the following diagram. Sew blocks into 3 rows as shown, then sew the columns together for the quilt top, pressing all seams open. The quilt top should measure approximately 72 ½" x 72 ½".



**FINISHED!!**

And there you have it! A beautiful 'magic carpet' quilt! Add borders if you wish, or not, quilt, bind or face. Be ready to reveal your creation at the January 2019 guild meeting!
