CHEMO SCARF JUST GOT EASIER!!!

Fabric Required: 3/4 Yard Batting Required: 2" x 15" Rectangle

From fabric, cut 27" square

Fold square into triangle, **wrong** sides together, and press on fold (*this is so pressed fold will* be on the **right** side later on.)

Place center of batting piece in center of fold (see diagram)

Machine baste batting to one side of the fold, matching center point of scarf to center point of batting, using same color thread you will use for topstitching later. (This is the new step, which eliminates the need for pins, and remains part of the finished scarf.)

With <u>right</u> sides together, sew 1/4" seam around perimeter of scarf — being sure to leave opening to turn right side out.

Clip corners

Turn right side out.

Poke corners out

Press

Topstitch 1/4" seam around the total scarf (right side out.) This will secure your batting again, finish the edge, and close the opening you left to turn scarf right side out.

Sew a few evenly spaced rows through the batting lengthwise and on the sides of the batting

Press

That's it!
