

HABITAT HOUSES

Directions for One House: (You will need 12 houses for the quilt.)

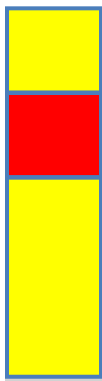
From Fabric A: One $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch square for window

From Fabric B: One $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch x $4\frac{1}{2}$ inch rectangle and One $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch square for window panel.

From Fabric C: One $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch x $8\frac{1}{2}$ inch rectangle for inner house panel.

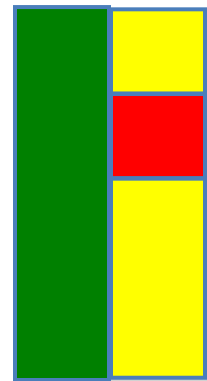
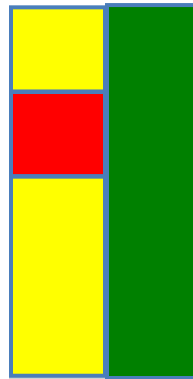
From Fabric D: Two $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch x $8\frac{1}{2}$ inch rectangles for outer house panels.

Sew Fabrics A and B together to make the window panel, as shown.

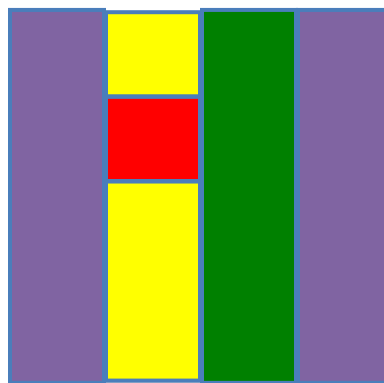
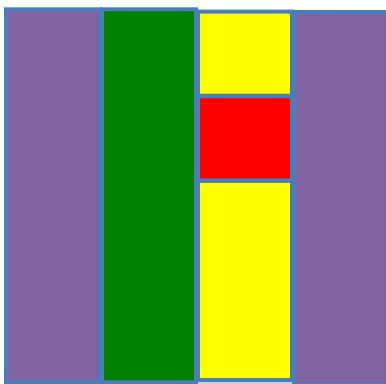


Sew inner panel to side of window panel as shown.

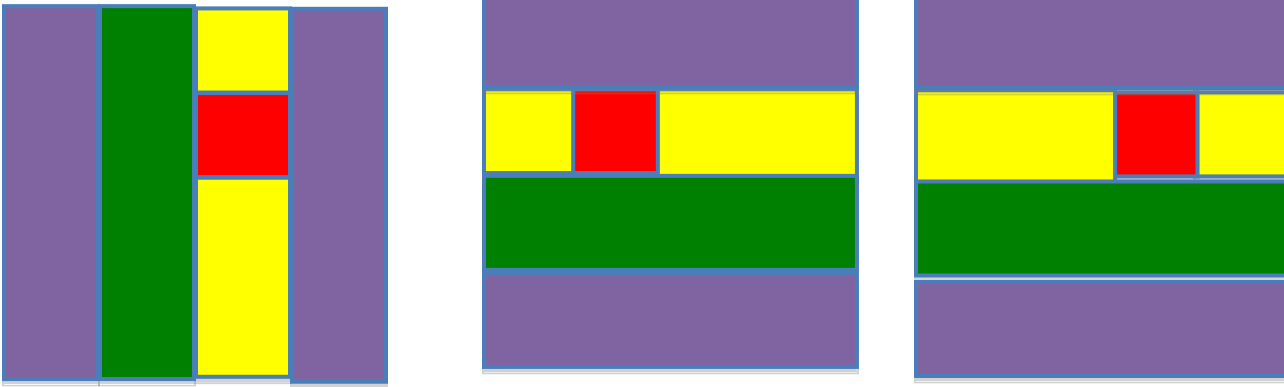
Sew 6 houses to the left side and 6 to the right side.



Sew outer panels to the house, one of either side.



Arrange the houses either vertically or horizontally some with window on right, some with window on left.



Directions for One Roof : (You will need 12 roof sections for the quilt.)

From Fabric E: One 2 ½ inch x 4 ½ inch rectangle and 2 ½ in x 8 ½ inch rectangle for roof.

From Fabric F: Two 2 ½ inch x 4 ½ inch rectangles and Two 2 ½ in squares for the sky.

Top Roof Section: With right sides together place one 2 ½ in x 4 ½ in sky piece at right angles with 2 ½ x 4 ½ roof piece. Draw a diagonal line as shown and sew on this line. Trim and press toward the sky fabric. See diagram below. Sew other 2 ½ x 4 ½ sky piece in the same way to get the roof peak.



Bottom Roof Section: With right sides together place a 2 ½ in square sky piece at each end of 2 ½ x 8 ½ rectangle roof piece.

Draw a diagonal line as shown and sew on the diagonal line. Press toward the sky and trim the excess fabric. Sew the two sections together. Sew the roof section to the house section to complete the block.



Sew blocks together: 3 rows of 4 houses in each row.

Add borders, quilt, and bind.
